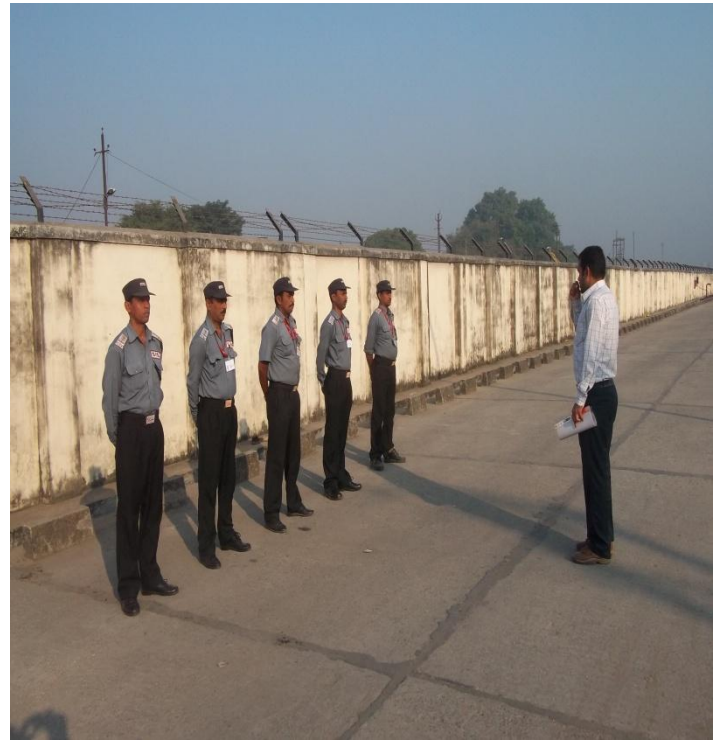

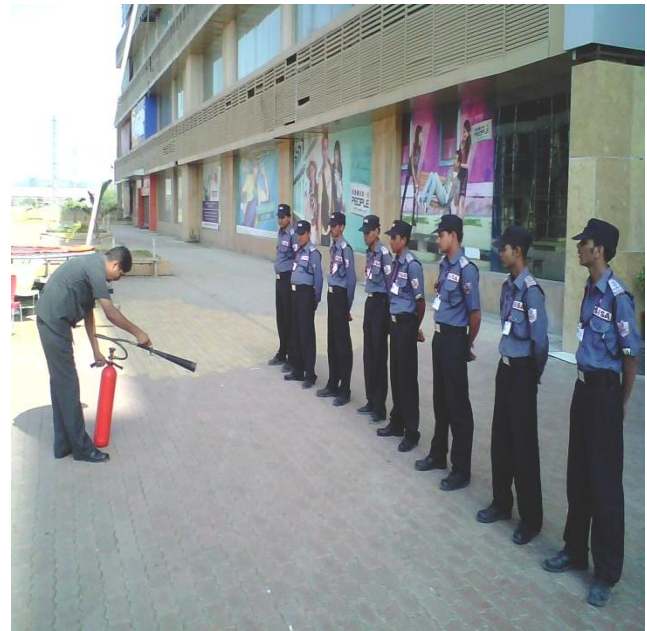

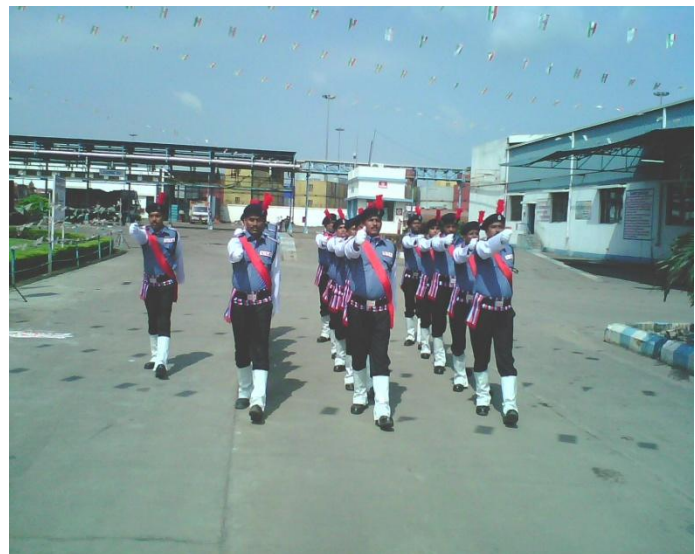

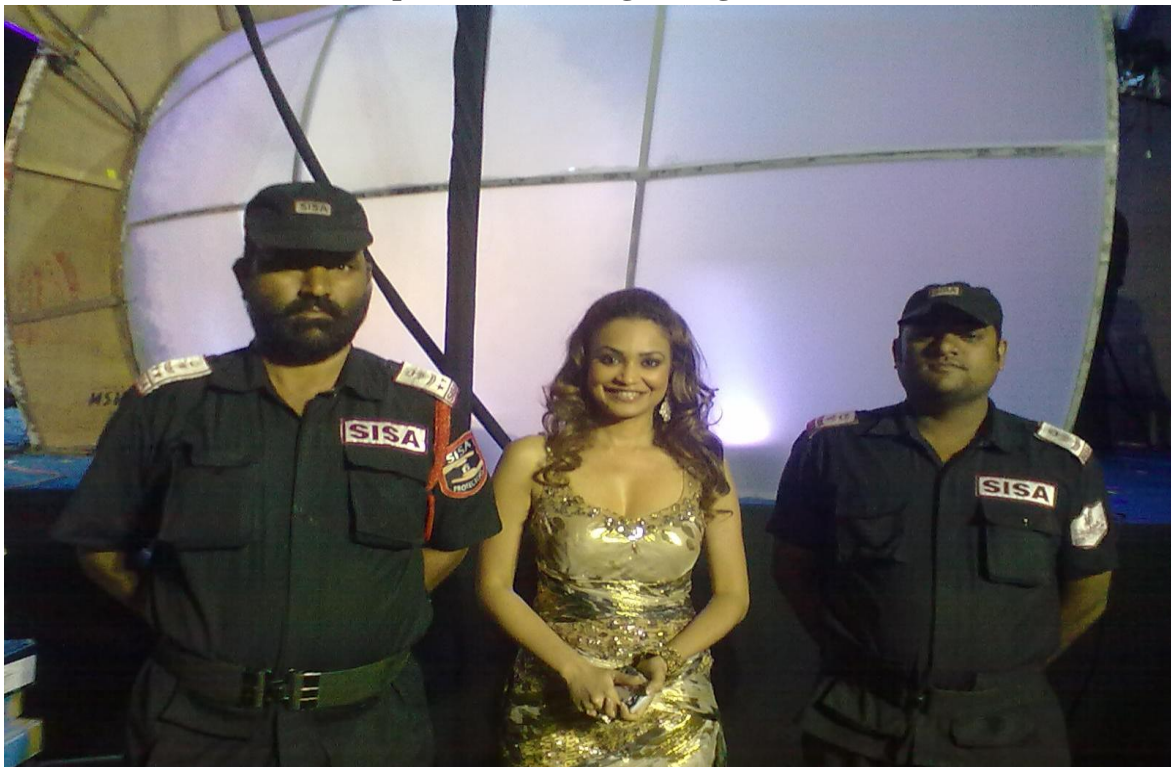

Face difficulties positively
