

I have extensively travelled every mountain path, passes, valleys and gorge in God's Abode, the Garhwal Himalayas. Let me tell you, there is NO PLACE on earth to compare with the beauty, grandeur, peace and spiritual sanctity of these mountains. Go there while there is still time, since the last time I went to Gaumukh, the glacial cow mouth shape had lost its natural shape.


Sleep well my friends, for the road is long and arduous.


